

officer issued a proposed order dismissing the petition. The Commission notified Petitioner by letter dated January 30, 2015 that he had 30 days to appeal the hearing officer's proposed decision to the Commission. No appeal was received.

In accordance with 24 P.S. § 2070.14, the decision of the hearing officer shall become final unless excepted to by either party within thirty days from the date of the recommended decision or unless the Commission initiates a review of the decision in the absence of exceptions or reopens the proceedings for the reception of further evidence. In the instant case, neither party has filed exceptions to the hearing officer's proposed order, and thus the Commission enters the following:

ORDER

AND NOW, this _____ day of April, 2015, it is hereby ORDERED that the Recommended Decision of the Hearing Officer is AFFIRMED AND ADOPTED and the Petition for Reinstatement filed by PETER G. WEINDORFER is hereby DISMISSED without prejudice.
