| ORDER LIFT | ING SUSPENSION |

On December 8, 2021, the Department of Education (Department) filed a Notice of Charges seeking the immediate suspension of Christopher P. Yoder's (Respondent) certificate and employment eligibility pursuant to section 9b(a)(1) of the Educator Discipline Act (Act). 24 P.S. § 2070.9b(a)(1). On February 4, 2022, after Respondent failed to respond to the Notice of Charges, a panel of members of the Commission convened a meeting to consider the Department's request for immediate suspension. By Order dated February 8, 2022, the Commission directed the Department to immediately suspend Respondent's certificate and employment eligibility.

Pursuant to section 9b(a)(1)(iii) of the Act, the Commission shall direct the Department to immediately lift a suspension upon receipt of certified court documents establishing that the criminal charges have been dismissed or otherwise removed.¹ 24 P.S. § 2070.9b(a)(1)(iii). The Commission is in receipt of certified court documents showing that Respondent was found "not guilty" on all counts. Thus, the Act mandates Respondent's immediate reinstatement.²

^{2.} The Commission will direct the Department to reinstate Respondent's certificate and employment eligibility effective December 15, 2023.

Order

AND NOW, this 1st day of February 2024, it is hereby Ordered:

- Pursuant to 24 P.S. § 2070.9b(a)(1)(iii), the Department shall lift the suspension and reinstate Respondent's certificate and eligibility to be employed as a charter or cyber charter school staff member or contracted educational provider staff member, effective December 15, 2023.
- 2. The Department may pursue discipline against Respondent on other available grounds if it determines that such action is warranted. 24 P.S. § 2070.9b(b).
